Clean Marina Corner

FACT: Products used to wash boat hulls and deck often contain toxic ingredients that are harmful to marine environment.

Toxic Product

Alternative

Toxic Product	Alternative
Detergent & Soap	Biodegradable Boat Soap
Bleach	Hydrogen peroxide
Scouring Powders	Baking soda or salt
Varnish Cleaner	Wipe with ½ cup vinegar and ½ cup water solution
Head Cleaner	Brush w/ baking soda
Aluminum Cleaner	2 TB. Cream of tarter in 1 quart water
Chrome Cleaner/Polish	Apple cider vinegar to clean; baby oil to polish
Fiberglass Stain Remover	Baking soda paste
Mildew Remover	Paste of equal parts lemon juice and salt
Wood Polish (interior unvarnished wood only)	3 parts olive oil and 1 part white vinegar
